### **COMMUNICATIONS PLAN**

Per its charge, the CAT developed and recommended to the Coordinating Team (CT) a Communications Plan for the Presbytery. The plan focused primarily on utilizing technologies to keep congregations and individuals fully informed of joint missional, education, and worship opportunities as well as the ecclesial activities of the Presbytery.

Our primary areas included in the plan that was submitted to the CT are: (1) websites; (2) email distribution groups; (3) email discussion groups; (4) email accounts in branded domain, e.g., pastor@eaglenestpc.org, clerk@sanluispc.org; (5) empower and support local (church) management of IT resources; (6) expand Nuevas Noticias distribution list; (7) solicit input to Nuevas Noticias; (8) support Presbytery FaceBook page; (9) explore usefulness of Twitter account; (10) provide IT support to local churches; (11) support local use of audio-video.

The CT recommended that the CAT also: (12) review descriptions of IT and social media positions; (13) support PSF sound system; (14) support Nuevas Noticias; (15) improve and enhance PSF website; (16) support webinars.
