

Education Networking Committee (ENC)
Report ~ Presbytery Meeting
June 24, 2017

The Education Networking Committee (ENC) of the Presbytery of Santa Fe continues to meet regularly every other month at the First Presbyterian Church of Albuquerque.

The ENC has received requests for three more Education Project Grants for the summer of 2017: the first is from Rio Rancho Presbyterian for \$750 for another summer of Vacation Bible School with Chacon and Mora young people in June. This program will be led by Kathy Westmoreland. And second, a request for \$500 came from White Rock Presbyterian Church, Los Alamos, for Vacation Bible School with the Navajo House of Fellowship at Bread Spring, NM. And third, First Presbyterian Church, Albuquerque, requested a \$355 grant for Sharon Yates for Godly Play training. Sharon will use her training in Spanish during the fall Cuba trip sponsored by the Presbytery.

The ENC networked with the First Presbyterian Church in the Brian McLaren event which was at the end of April, as well as the Mission Networking Committee (MNC) event on dismantling racism which was at the first of April.

The ENC invited Luke Rembold to become part of the committee in order to support Youth and Young Adult Ministries in the Presbytery. Luke attended his first meeting in May.

The ENC is exploring new events to be held in the northern churches, as well as events for millennial members of our churches. Watch for announcements of upcoming educational events to be held in your areas.
